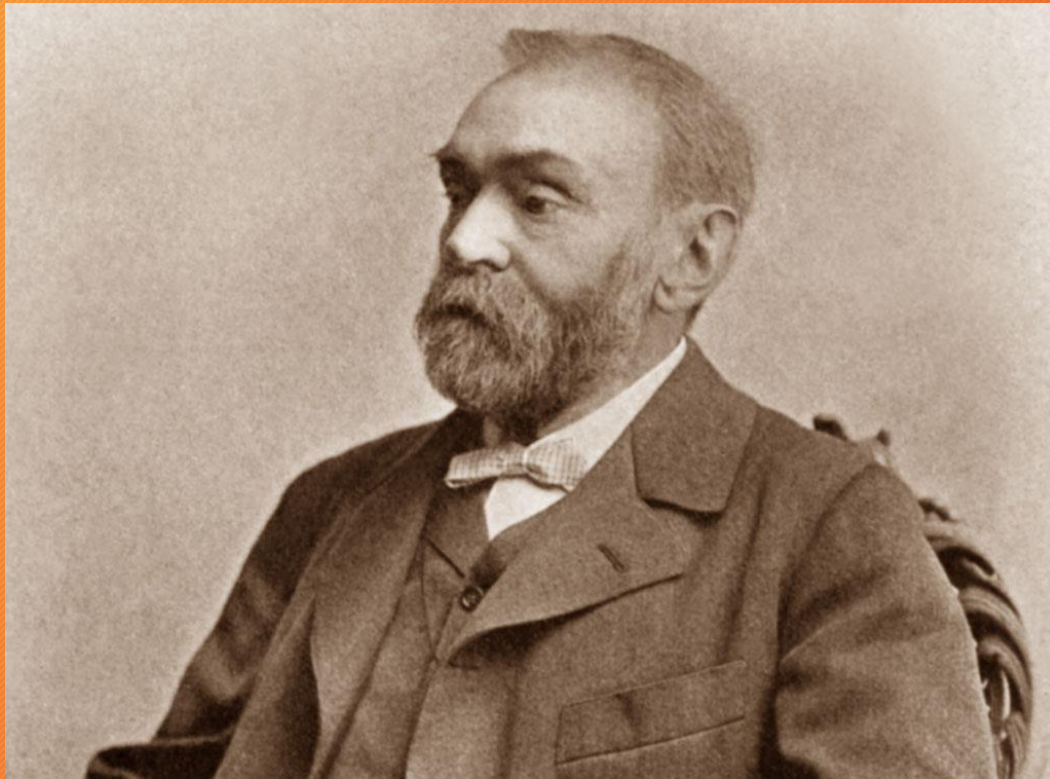

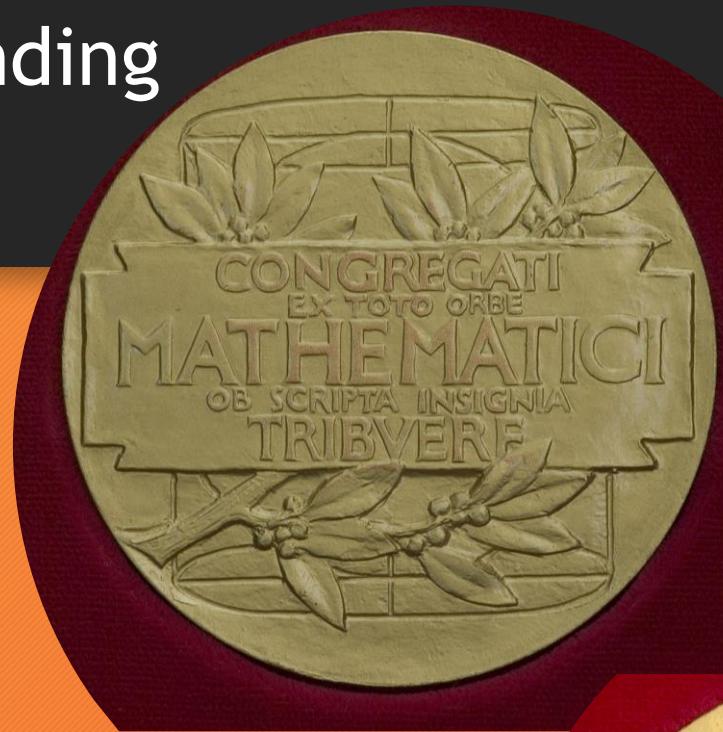

"Transire suum pectus mundoque potiri."

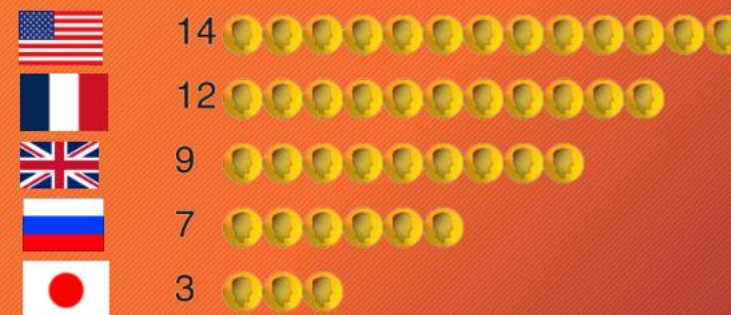
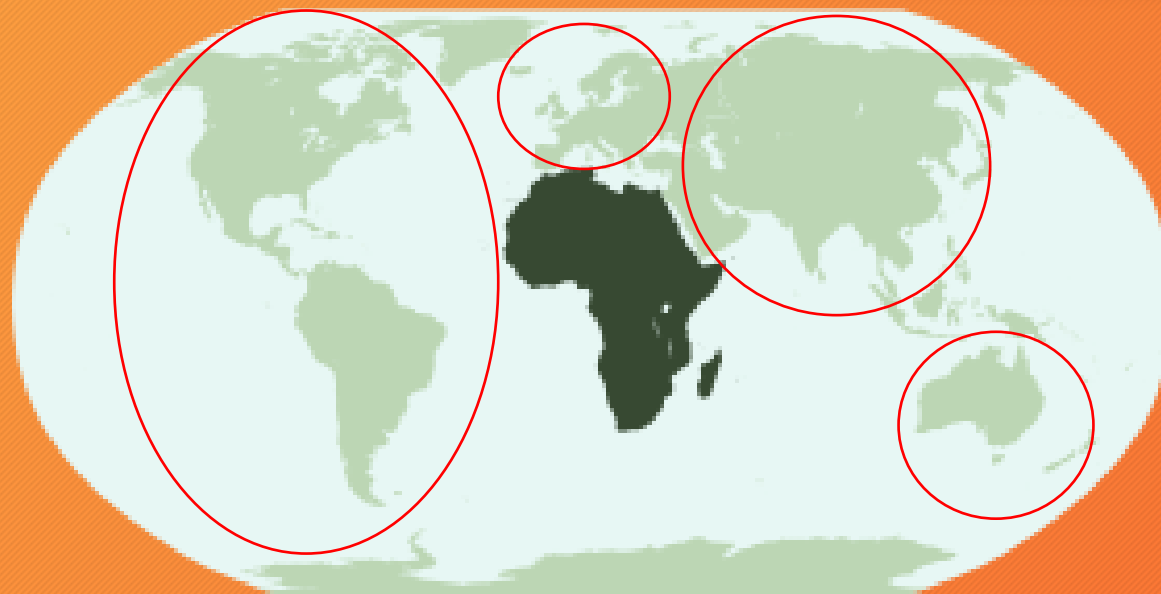

68 Medals From 24 Countries (+ 1 Apolide) From 4 Continents

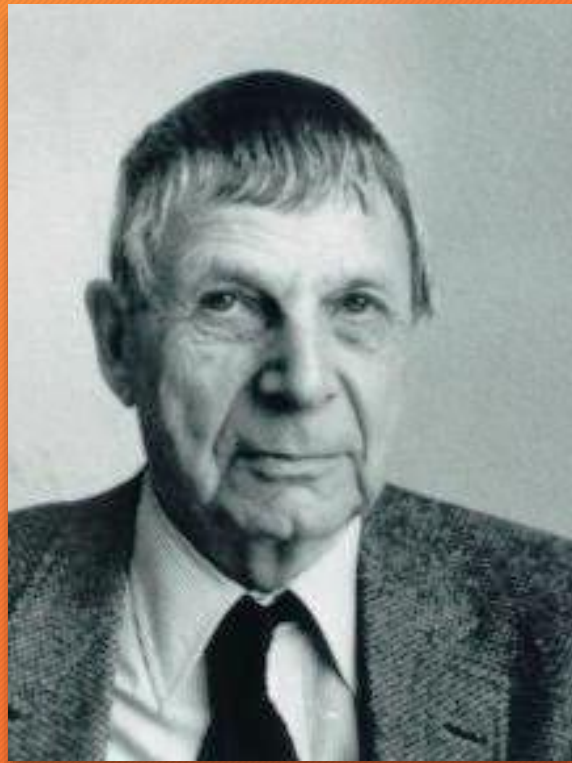

- Serre is also, up to now, the only mathematician to whom were awarded both the Fields Medal and the Abel Prize.

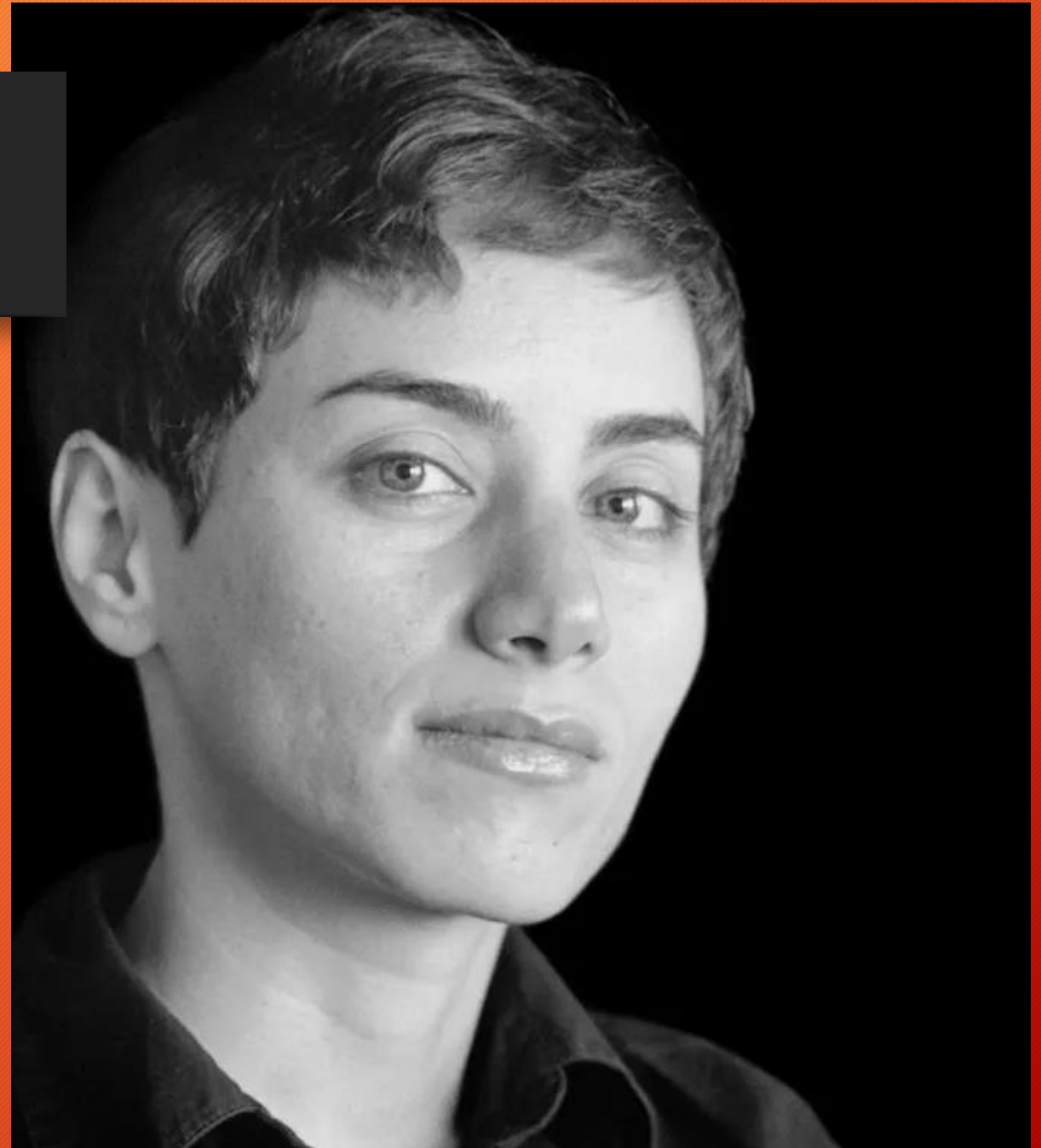

The Second Woman (Helsinki, 2022)

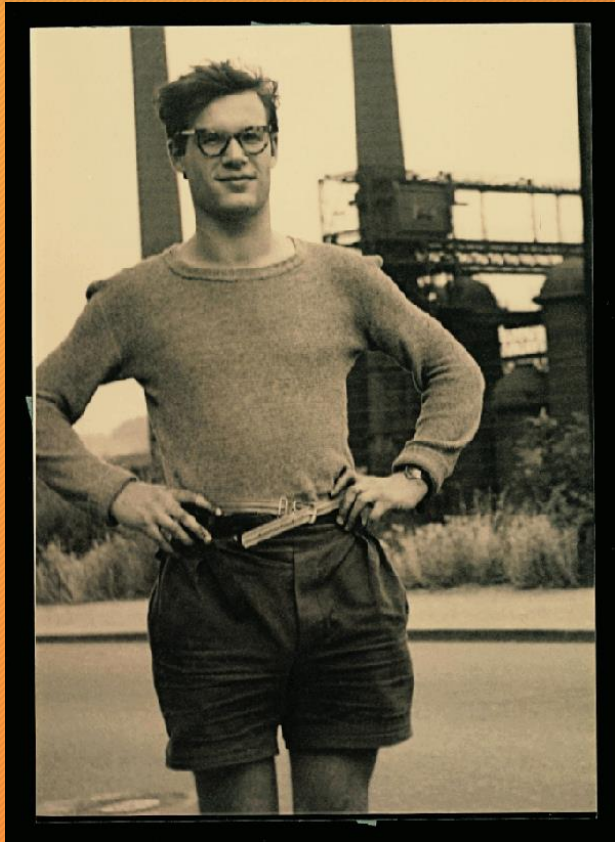
- Maryna is a Ukrainian mathematician teaching at the Federal Polytechnic of Lausanne (Switzerland).

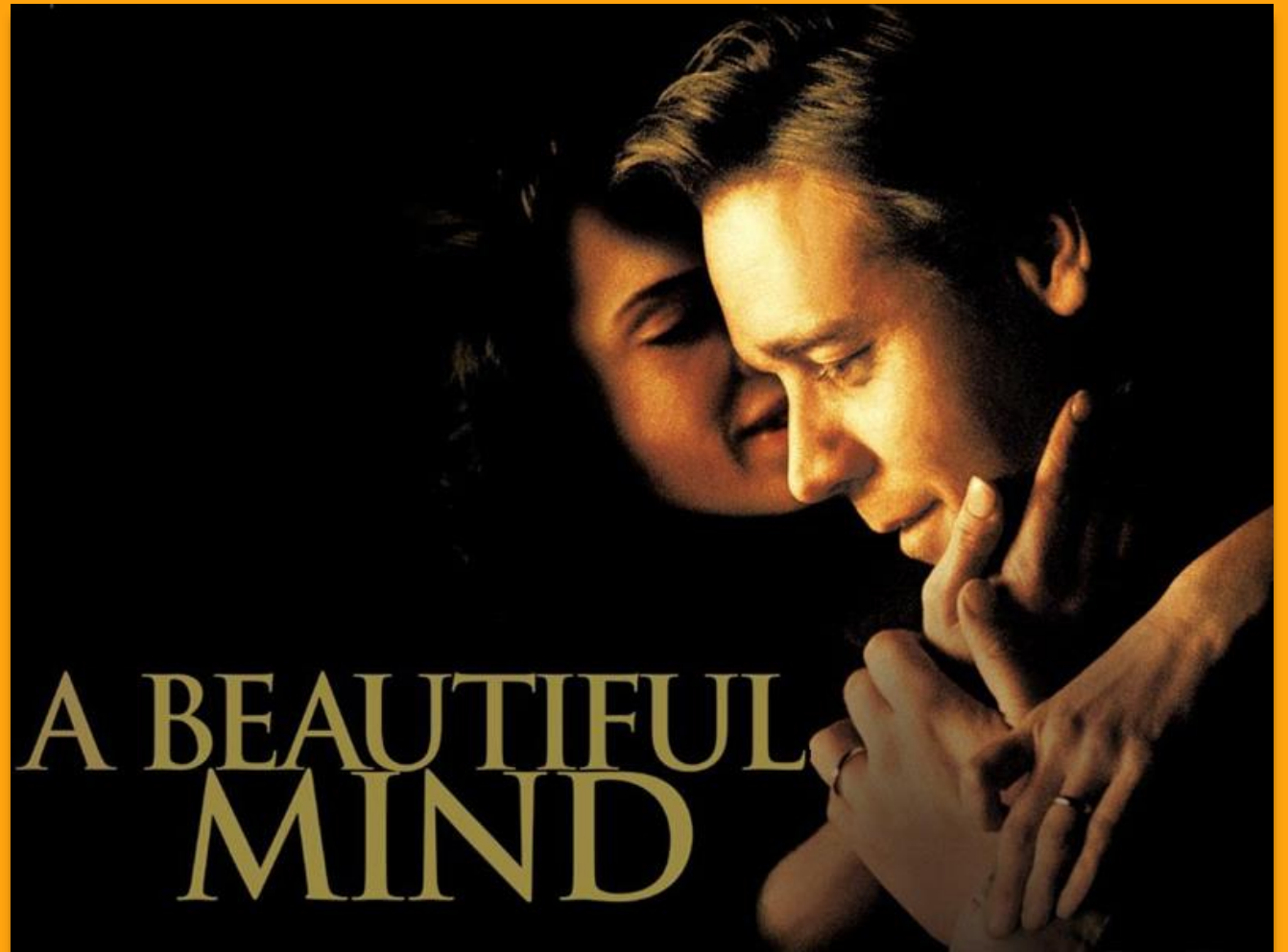

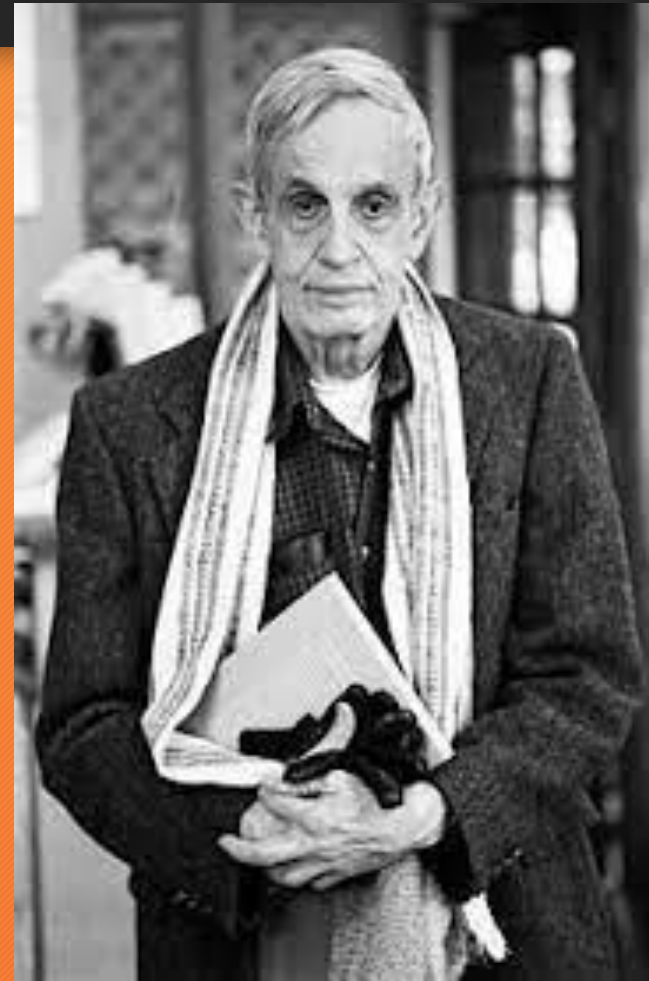

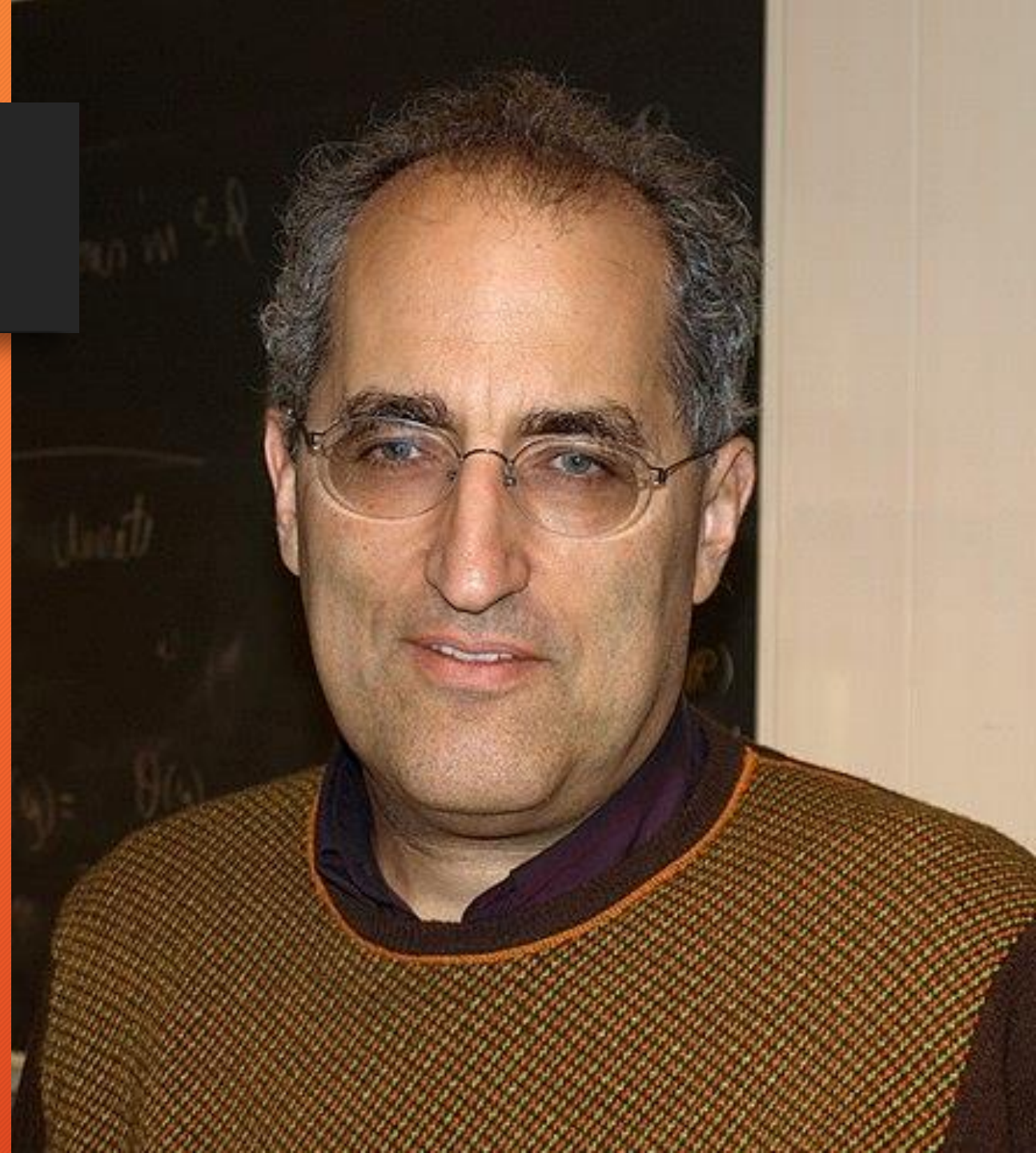
- A silver plaque was given to him during the opening ceremony of the International Congress of Mathematicians of Berlin by the President of the International Mathematical Union who said:

The Quantum Fields Medal (Kyoto, 1990)

- Witten is a famous theoretical physicist who worked on quantum fields. He is the only non-mathematician to whom was awarded a Fields Medal.
